- **This is an outdoor venue, and there will be no wi-fi available.**
- No outside raffles or draws permitted.
- Vendors can arrive beginning at 8:00 am or after, but must be set up no later than 10:30 am on both Saturday & Sunday.
- Tear down no later than 5:00 pm on Sunday, May 28, 2023.
- Register on-site at the Vendor registration booth when you arrive to receive your location number.

- Only low noise generators are allowed to be used on site.
- **All food vendors must agree to allow all 44<sup>th</sup> Traditional Pow Wow Volunteers, Ambassadors and Staff to use “Chits” to purchase food. These chits can be exchanged for money at the end of each day from the Vendor Coordinator. This will allow for both; vendors to increase sales and for the Pow Wow Helpers to be fed.**

- I understand that neither the ONFC nor the Canadian Police College are responsible for damages, stolen articles belonging to vendors, or personal injuries to vendors or their helpers during this event. No Drugs or Alcohol are allowed inside the grounds at any time can or this can result in immediate removal.
